Medications

Your doctor will work in partnership with you to determine the best course of medication assisted treatment.

Suboxone (Buprenorphine)


Suboxone is a medication used to treat opioid addiction. When taken daily, it decreases withdrawal symptoms for about 24 hours. This medication is indicated for pregnant women addicted to opioids. Suboxone was approved for use by the FDA in 2002.

Vivitrol (Naltrexone)

Vivitrol is a medication often used to manage alcohol addiction and opioid addiction. This medication was approved for use in the US in 1984. Vivitrol decreases opioid cravings, but may take longer than Suboxone to be effective.

Methadone (Dolophine)

Methadone is used to treat opioid addiction. While a single dose has a rapid effect, maximum effect can take up to five days of use. This medication was approved for use in the US in 1947. This medication is indicated for pregnant women addicted to opioids. Methadone reduction is suitable for those who wish to completely stop using drugs, but can also be used for maintenance for those with high levels of addiction and a history of numerous relapse attempts.
