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Emergency Crisis Services

Individuals do not need an appointment to have an emergency evaluation completed. Evaluations are provided for individuals of all ages. You will be evaluated by one of our clinicians who will determine the level of care most appropriate for you. If inpatient treatment is indicated, our treatment team of psychiatrists, psychiatric nurses, therapists, behavioral healthcare coordinators, and care managers will then work with you to help you become stabilized. Our clinicians can complete evaluations in the hospital emergency room, at the county jail, police department, local nursing homes, boarding homes, and other community settings in order to assess your situation and assist you in getting appropriate treatment. Youth 15 years and older can be seen without their parents' consent. Any individual who is intoxicated or under the influence of alcohol or other illegal substance may need to go through detox in order to be thoroughly and competently evaluated.

Therapy & Case Management

Our masters-level therapists offer strengths-focused, evidence-based, and culturally-sensitive therapy to adults, children, and families. Our case managers are skilled in helping families identify their specific needs and locate the appropriate resources to meet those needs. Case managers can offer in-home services when needed. Our therapists have diverse backgrounds and are experienced in areas of cognitive and behavioral therapy, play therapy, art therapy, EMDR, motivational interviewing, and dual diagnosis.

Child & Adolescent Behavioral Health

Children and adolescents typically face challenges at all ages that are unique to their genetics, individual development, past experiences, and family culture. As we recognize the individual needs of our clients, we offer a variety of services geared to meet each child's specific needs and encourage healthy development. Our therapists, case management services are available, and psychiatrists share a common goal, and work together to provide services for children between birth and 18 years of age. They utilize best practices that focus on the strengths of the child and his/her family, thus promoting strong relationships and healthy futures for each child enrolled in the program.

Early Childhood Services

As a parent, you may wonder whether your toddler's temper tantrums are "normal," or why your three year old prefers communicating physically rather than verbally, or whether you should be concerned if your preschooler displays a fascination with fires, or is intent to hurt animals. What is normal behavior? When should you be concerned? Thanks to funding from the State of Colorado for community behavioral health centers, Spanish Peaks Behavioral Health Centers developed an Early Childhood Program for children from birth to 8 years of age and their parents. Behavioral health services will be provided to families with preschool kids who have no health insurance or do not qualify for Medicaid under this program. These services are also available to those with Medicaid, other insurance benefits, and cash or credit card.



Acute Treatment Unit in Pueblo, CO

The Acute Treatment Unit (ATU) is a 16-bed inpatient facility for men and women 18 years of age or older who are in an emotional crisis or have a serious psychiatric issue. It is offered as a less restrictive alternative to hospitalization. The ATU provides a safe and secure environment for individuals who do not require hospitalization or an extended length of stay.





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
