



Youth and Family Services Program Highlights

- Our outpatient services offer a variety of programs geared to meet each child's specific needs and encourage healthy development.
- Our professionals provide treatment to over 400 youth and families with the goal of building healthy relationships within the family and helping youth focus on positive changes.
- In collaboration with Pueblo School Districts #60 and #70, our team works to educate students on the negative impact of drugs in the school setting. Our team of professionals is committed to preventing students from expulsion and encourages opportunities for second chances to complete their education.
- Our Advanced Clinical Experts (ACE Clinicians) provide specialized services including:
 - Trauma-focused therapy
 - Anger management
 - Horticultural group
 - Art therapy, and more



KEEPS CHILDREN IN THEIR HOMES

MULTISYSTEMIC THERAPY (MST)

An intense evidence-based home and community-based program focused on empowering families to build healthier environments through the mobilization of existing child, family, and community strengths and resources. MST addresses risk factors in an individualized, comprehensive, and integrated approach, allowing families to enhance relationships and creating positive family environments.

CLIENT SUCCESS

During the past year, our MST professionals worked with a 12-year-old Pueblo County client who successfully completed the MST program and went on to earn a prominent community award in recognition of his commitment to turning his life around.

FIRST EPISODE PSYCHOSIS (FEP) PROGRAM

FEP program treats psychosis, which affects about 3 out of 100 people at some point in their lives. With early treatment, some people never have another psychotic episode and for others, psychosis may be a recurring symptom of schizophrenia and another mental illness. Early treatment provides a foundation for recovery and full life.

Health Solutions FEP program supports and improves outcomes for youth and young adults between the ages of 15-29. Our FEP team is comprised of a diverse group of clinical experts as well as education and employment specialists committed to assisting families who care for their loved ones. Our goal is to provide the assistance necessary to support and establish healthy, independent lifestyles.

Resources to support independent living include, but are not limited to:

- Completing GED or obtaining high school diplomas.
- Education and awareness on obtaining a driver's license and navigating bus routes.
- Safe space to socialize, study, practice healthy boundaries and meet with peers.



RISE TO SUCCESS

Awarded the Golden Light Bulb Award by the Colorado Behavioral Health Council in 2019 for innovation, Rise to Success is a unique childcare program that was established in response to the COVID 19 pandemic and the growing workforce and client care challenges. Committed to providing client care needs and assisting staff with a childcare options, Rise to Success became a safe, social and learning environment where our staff's children could attend at no charge to them. This unique and innovative program was staffed by trained tutors and retired teachers to assist participants with the necessary remote learning during school closures.

There are numerous successes to be celebrated this past year:

- Many new rituals and now practices daily are:
 - Wish you Well
 - Time Machine
 - Story Time CD Books
 - o Daily Schedule
 - Breathing
 - Songs and Chants
 - Emotion Faces
 - Discussion
 - Greetings

Children have learned the importance of wishing each other well when some are feeling sad or having a difficult time. Children utilize the Time Machine to problem solve with one another and partake in the daily ritual by sharing the day's highlights and lows.

Rock Climbing Wall

A big hit for our children, our rock climbing wall affords kids the opportunity to build confidence and a sense of accomplishment. As they problem solve and make decisions, the adaptive wall helps kids practice balance, build body awareness, increase muscle strength and develop motor skills.





Care Coordination

COMPLEX CARE MANAGEMENT

• In collaboration with Health Solutions Medical Center, our Health Care Plus team launched the "complex care pilot program" to address the needs of our high-need, complex, Health First Colorado members. This pilot program was designed to improve care, increase levels of engagement, reduce costs for members, and maintain the ability for the programming to be replicated in other organizations for primary care medical practice offices.





COLLABORATION

Our Care Coordination Department, in partnership with Parkview Health Systems, utilizes Pieces-IRIS platform that allows our team to accept referrals for clients who are in need of our services.
 Pieces-IRIS connects care providers to actionable data, people to services, and caseworkers to information. Pieces make it easier to input, manage, store, organize and gain insight from the data that's critical for us to help clients.

INTEGRATION OF CARE INTO CRISIS SERVICES

Town or the last

 In an effort to assist our Crisis team with initial medical assessments for our clients, our Care Coordination Department integrated three registered nurses into our Crisis services through our Crisis Living Room. By doing so, our clients receive the necessary assessments to assist in determining appropriate levels of care and additional wraparound service/resources.

PRIMARY CARE ADMIT, DISCHARGE (ADT) AND TRANSFER PILOT

 Our Care Coordination Team provides transitional support for more than 50 primary care clinics in our tri-county area. The team is comprised of Registered Nurses and Case Managers that assist with individuals admitted, discharged, or transferred to different levels of care to provide continuity of care.



DBT is a type of talk therapy for individuals who experience emotions very intensely. There are three ways for clients to learn and apply the highly effective skills and concepts from DBT:

- Full commitment to one year of comprehensive DBT.
- Full commitment to a weekly skills group.
- Drop-in skills training group for those who are not yet ready/able to commit to recurring groups or comprehensive treatment.

Coping Skills group facilitated in Spanish

Co-facilitated by a bi-lingual licensed clinician and a clinical core specialist who are committed to ensuring services are available to those who would otherwise be limited by a language barrier.

Activity Therapy

AOP offers clients the benefits of creative activities for coping and symptom management through weekly crafting to cope group and drop-in Creative Expressions Group.

Extended Programming Groups

Offered in three-hour blocks that allow for indepth interventions, longer format programming supports clients in need of structure and more intensive treatment.

Adapted Extended Programming

This three-hour block programming is offered once a week and adapts to meet the unique needs of individuals with developmental and intellectual disabilities as well as those who struggle with the cognitive impacts of their mental illness. This program aims to empower individuals to learn and use new skills and strategies to enhance their quality of life and manage their mental health conditions.



CLIENT IMPACT FUND

Driven by the Health Solutions Human Kindness initiative, the Client Impact Fund is meant to fulfill client needs that may not otherwise be available through other community resources/organizations. Oftentimes, social determinants have significant negative impacts on those we serve and it is our intent and commitment to providing resources that will improve client wellness, quality of life, and stability while in treatment. Since its inception in 2019, our Client Impact Fund has fulfilled over 500 Client Impact Fund Requests.

Financial support comes from a variety of partnerships, employee contributions, community support and fundraising activities.






